

MOTM MEMBERSHIP TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. The applicant must satisfy one of the following conditions when applying for membership:

- applicant is at least 55 years old
- the spouse of the applicant is a MILLIKEN ON THE MOVE – OLDER ADULTS CLUB (MOTM-OAC) current member who is 55+
- He/She applies for membership with their legal spouse who is 55+ years of age **at the same time.**

2. Successful applicants will be given a membership ID card valid for one year. Members are required to

- wear/show this membership ID card and
- sign the attendance sheet

when participating in any MOTM-OAC programs. Members failing to do the above will be asked to provide proof of ID by program staff or conveners.

3. MOTM-OAC will consist of a minimum of **75% Markham residents** and a maximum of **25% non-residents.**

4. City of Markham provides space for all programs. Instructional fees are absorbed in full by participants in instructor-led programs. Day-to-day operations of all programs are run by Club volunteers. Therefore, members must also have the obligation to help run the Club and these programs when volunteers are needed. Without any volunteers, the running of any programs will be at risk.

5. Weather cancellation:

No member is expected to endanger him/herself travelling to or from the centre. If the centre is operating normally and a member determines that travel to the centre is too hazardous, he or she may, at their sole discretion, choose not to attend their class(es).

6. **Photos and videos** are taken at programs and events. It is the participant's responsibility to let the photographer know if they do not want their photos/video taken. It is also the participant's responsibility to ensure they are not in a picture/video. If a photo/video of you is taken, posted, or used by MOTM, the participant will need to inform MOTM and allow time for MOTM to remove the picture/video in a timely manner. I understand that the photos/videos are not used for making a profit, and it is solely being taken and posted as a service to our club members to have as a record of their activities at MOTM.

7. MOTM-OAC Code of Conduct

The purpose of the policy is to promote an atmosphere of friendliness and tranquility within the Club. It is meant to promote and ensure acceptable behaviour.

Unacceptable behaviour includes the following:

- Loud verbal assaults
- Threats and/or attempts to intimidate
- Aggressive approaches to another individual or group
- Physically striking another individual
- Racial or ethnic slurs
- Abusive language
- Damage to property

The consequences of any of these incidents can be any of the following:

- Letter of reprimand
- Suspension from the Club
- Repeat offences will be dealt with more severely and may result in the revoking of Club membership.
